## **Praying with Mandalas** Led by Rev. Carr

"Mandala" is a Sanskrit word meaning circle. It can appear as a drawing, a mathematical formula, a dance or the center of a flower. Spiritually, it represents the One, the origin, the center of all visible nature. Together we will explore various mandalas and their meanings, and create some of our own. We will color mandalas, build mandalas, and discover what it means to move toward the Sacred Center on our journey through Lent toward Easter. Bring your own colored pencils. Other materials will be provided.

#### **Fasting as a Spiritual Discipline** Led by Rev. Robertson

Meets Tuesday and Friday mornings, 8:00 a.m.; February 20 through March 30.

Fasting is a spiritual practice that is extolled throughout the Bible and in all the major religions of the world. It places us where God blesses and transforms us. We consume less in order to deepen our relationship with God. It can include, for example, cutting back on unhealthy calories, excessive use of electronic devices, unnecessary shopping, consumption of alcohol, etc. We'll learn this practice together, keeping in touch with the Holy Spirit and with each other, meeting for about 15 minutes twice each week.

#### **Lenten Devotional Group** Led by Rev. Carr
